Workshop Description:

Join Pamela in an inspiring three-day workshop into narrative mosaic. Where do ideas come from? What materials should you choose? What technique should you employ to explore the story you want to tell? Learn the difference between intrinsic and extrinsic tesserae. This workshop is suited to beginner or advanced mosaic practitioners.

Materials to bring: Mosaic nippers, tweezers, palette knife, pen, pencil, paper as well as a collection of tesserae that speak to you or may help you evoke a narrative. These do not have to be traditional mosaic tesserae but could be found objects or other small items such as jewellery, beads, metal, shells, plastic items etc...



Supplied: Substrate (30 x 40cm), adhesives, colourants and a broad range of tesserae will be supplied in a range of colours to supplement your own personal selection.

About Pamela: Pamela Irving has worked as a full-time artist for over 30 years. Her sense of humour, love of irony and respect for storytelling are apparent in her varied body of work. She works across media to create mosaics, sculptures, paintings drawings and large scale public works. Pamela’s works are represented in public and private collections, including the Museum of Art Ravenna, City of Melbourne, Museum Victoria, State Library Victoria, Art Bank, Regional galleries, Municipal and school collections. Pamela is a visiting tutor at the Chicago Mosaic School each year and her course is part of their accreditation program.
